



“Bottoms Up” Finch Feeder

For easy filling, slide the metal cap evenly up the bail wire and it will fall to the side.

All Droll Yankees Feeders can be disassembled for easy cleaning or replacing parts.

Cleaning: Please for the sake of the birds, keep your feeders clean! Dirty feeders can harm the birds. Use a mild soap and water solution and a soft bristle brush for thorough and simple cleaning. Dry completely before filling with seed.

Disassemble

1. Remove the top cap by sliding the cap up the bail wire and gently pull each end of the bail wire out of the bail rod.
2. Squeeze tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with the bail rod, and reach inside the tube and remove the bail rod.
3. With feeder in a horizontal position, push downward against each perch rod on a flat surface until they are pushed through to the opposite side and remove.
4. Remove the base and clear baffle by unscrewing the binding post screw and pull the binding post barrel out from the opposite side.

Assemble

1. Install the bail rod by squeezing the tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with both holes which accepts the bail rod and insert bail rod into the holes on the tube.
2. Perch Rod Installation: **Note:** For easier insertion, place perch rods in freezer for 20-30 minutes. **Do not hammer perch rods into the feeder tube. Do not drill holes larger. The perch rods must fit tightly.**
 - a. Hold a perch rod upright on a flat surface. With feeder in a horizontal position, line up the perch rod with the perch rod hole on the feeder.
 - b. Push the feeder down onto the perch rod, allowing the rod to push up through the perch rod hole. Align the partially inserted rod with the exit hole and push until the rod extends equally on both sides of the tube.
3. Install the baffle on the base. Place tube on the base aligning the small holes on both the base and the tube. Slide the binding post barrel through the hole on one side of the base and screw the binding post screw into the binding post barrel.
4. Replace cap by inserting each end of the bail wire into the bail rod and slide cap down into place on the tube.
