



## Classic A-6F (re-introduced) Sunflower/Mixed Seed Feeder

For easy filling, slide the metal cap evenly up the bail wire and it will fall to the side.

All Droll Yankees Feeders can be disassembled for easy cleaning or replacing parts.

**Cleaning:** Please for the sake of the birds, keep your feeders clean! Dirty feeders can harm the birds. Use a mild soap and water solution and a soft bristle brush for thorough and simple cleaning. Dry completely before filling with seed.

### Disassemble

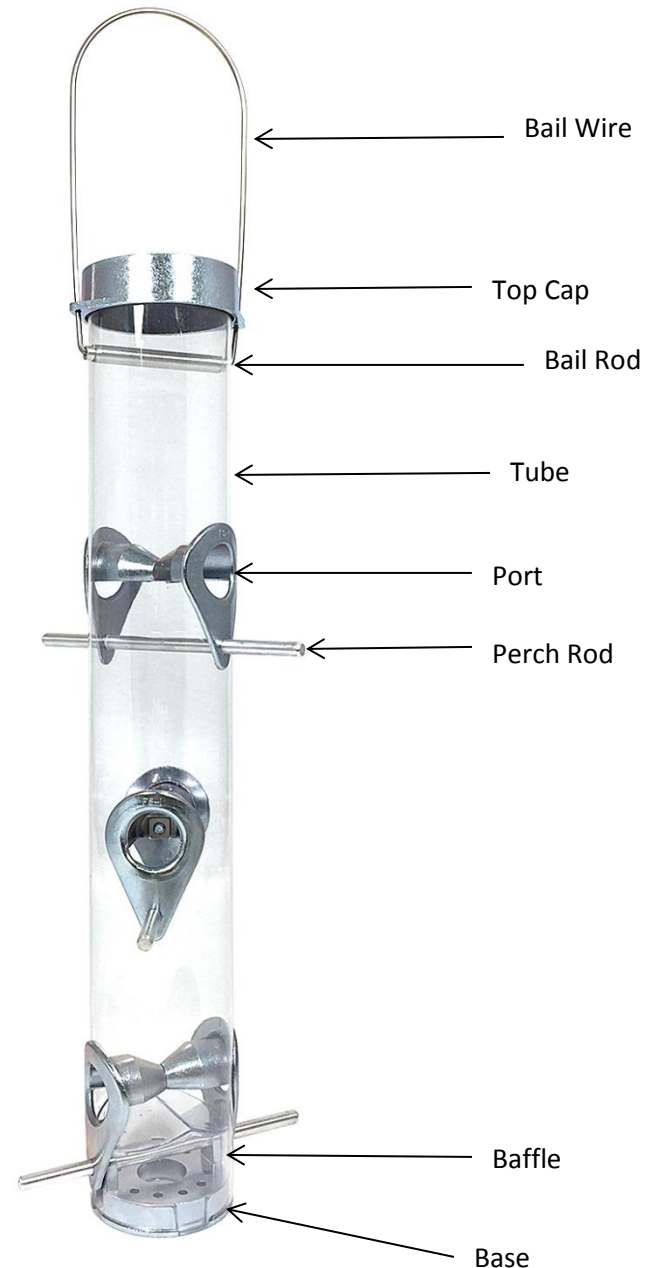
1. Remove the top cap by sliding the cap up the bail wire and gently pull each end of the bail wire out of the bail rod.
2. Squeeze the tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with the bail rod, and reach inside tube and remove the bail rod.
3. With feeder in a horizontal position, push downward against each perch rod on a flat surface until it is pushed further through to the opposite side and remove.

**Note: Removal of the bottom perch rod will release the base and baffle.**

4. Disassemble each pair of ports which are held together with a nut and a Phillips screw.

### Assemble

1. Port Assembly: First, place Phillips screws in their holes on half of the ports. While tube is in a horizontal position, hold nut in place on port with finger while placing port onto tube. Take a port with Phillips screw and place opposite of the port with nut and tighten Phillips screw. Make certain that the hole in bottom of port is aligned with the perch rod hole in tube. Do not completely tighten Phillips screws until perch rods are inserted into feeder.
2. Install the baffle on the base. Place tube on the base aligning perch rod holes on bottom ports with the holes in base. Attach base and baffle by inserting bottom perch rod.
3. Perch Rod Installation: **Note: For easier insertion, place perch rods in freezer for 20-30 minutes.**
  - a. Hold a perch rod in an upright position on a carpeted area or workbench. With the feeder in a horizontal position, line up the perch rod with the perch rod hole in the feeder. Push the feeder down onto the perch rod, allowing the rod to push up through the tube.
  - b. Align the partially inserted rod with the exit hole and push until the rod extends equally on both sides of the tube.
4. Install the bail rod by squeezing the tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with both holes which accepts the bail rod and insert bail rod into the holes on tube.
5. Replace top cap by inserting each end of the bail wire into the bail rod and slide top cap down into place on the tube.



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
