The Winner (W-1) Window Feeder

All Droll Yankees Feeders can be disassembled for easy cleaning or replacing parts.

Cleaning: Please for the sake of the birds, keep your feeders clean! Dirty feeders can harm the birds. Use a mild soap and water solution and a soft bristle brush for thorough and simple cleaning. Dry completely before filling with seed, fruit, mealworms or suet.

Disassemble

1. Remove the feeder from the bar with suction cups and bumper with suction cup by lifting the feeder gently upward.
2. Bar with suction cups and bumper with suction cup can be removed from window by gently lifting edge of each suction cup.
3. While holding the brass rod, spin the dome counter-clockwise to remove from brass rod.
4. Turn the thumb screw counter-clockwise and pull brass rod out of plastic column of dish.

Assemble

1. Insert the smooth end of brass rod into the plastic column of dish halfway and tighten thumbscrew by turning it clockwise.
2. Place metal insert located in center of dome on threaded end of rod and turn the dome clockwise until tight and correctly positioned over dish.
3. Adjust height of dome by turning the thumbscrew counter-clockwise and moving rod up or down to the desired height and tighten thumbscrew.
4. Before placing the bumper with suction cup and bar with suction cups on a clean, dry window, rub a little oil from the side of your nose onto the suction cups.
5. Position and press bumper with suction cup against window at desired height.
6. While feeder is sitting on level surface, place bar with suction cups under the lip on the backside of dome holding the bar on both ends making certain that the arrow in center of bar with suction cups is pointing upward and the writing imprinted on the bar can be read.
7. Position and hook the lip on the dish gently onto the bumper with suction cup and press bar with suction cups horizontally against window making certain that it is level.
