



## HOW TO ATTACH YOUR CAGE

Your new cage is designed for use with a tubular bird feeder with a diameter of 2 ½” or 3 ½”. If the cover fit is too tight, enlarge the opening using a file.

### **Attaching to a feeder with a removable cap, such as Droll Yankees New Generation® 15” feeder**

1. Remove the top cap by sliding the cap up and pulling the bail wire (handle) out of the bail rod.
2. Squeeze the tube slightly so that you can remove the bail rod out of the tube.
3. Slide the cover onto the tube.
4. Squeeze the spring clamp to fit over the tube and slide it down.
5. Install the bail rod and attach the cap.
6. Slide the feeder into the cage and attach using the threaded plug.
7. Adjust the position of the spring clamp so that it's holding the cover snugly against the top of the cage.

### **Attaching to a feeder with a fixed cap, such as the Droll Yankees A-6 or B-7**

1. Remove the top cap by cutting off or straightening the bent ends of the bail wire (handle) and pulling the wire up through the bail rod and the cap.
2. Remove the bail rod.
3. Slide the cover down onto the tube.
4. Squeeze the spring clamp to fit over the tube and slide it down.
5. Install the bail rod and attach the cap.
6. Slide the bail wire through the holes in the cap and then through the bail rod.
7. Using pliers, bend the ends of the bail wire to 90° angles.
8. Slip the feeder into the cage unit and attach it using the threaded plug.
9. Adjust the position of the spring clamp so that it's holding the cover snugly against the top of the cage.
