The New Generation/CJ Series Nyjer® Seed Feeder

For easy filling, slide the metal cap evenly up the bail wire and it will fall to the side.

All Droll Yankees Feeders can be disassembled for easy cleaning or part replacement.

Cleaning: Please for the sake of the birds, keep your feeders clean! Dirty feeders can harm the birds. Use a mild soap and water solution and a soft bristle brush for thorough and simple cleaning. Dry completely before filling with seed.

Disassemble

1. Remove the top cap by sliding the cap up the bail wire. Gently pull each end of the bail wire out of the bail rod.
2. Squeeze the tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with the bail rod, and reach inside the tube and remove the bail rod.
3. Remove the perch rods by holding the feeder in a horizontal position. Push the feeder down onto the perch rod on a carpeted area or work bench, allowing the perch rod to push up through on the opposite side. Pull perch rod from the tube.
Note: Removal of the bottom perch rod will release the base.

Assemble

1. Install bail rod by squeezing the tube, slightly oblong in shape, horizontal with both holes which accepts the bail rod and insert bail rod into the holes on tube.
2. Perch Rod Installation: **Note:** For easier insertion, place perch rods in freezer for 20-30 minutes. **Do not hammer perch rods into the feeder tube. Do not drill holes larger. The perch rods must fit tightly.**
 - a. Take your feeder to a carpeted area or work bench.
 - b. Hold a perch rod in an upright position. With the feeder in a horizontal position, line up the perch rod with the perch rod hole in the feeder. Push the feeder down onto the perch rod, allowing the rod to push up through the tube.
 - c. Align the partially inserted rod with the exit hole and push until the rod extends equally on both sides of the tube.**Note:** Remember to place base on tube before inserting the bottom perch rod.
3. Replace cap by inserting each end of the bail wire into the bail rod and slide cap down into place on the tube.
