Once a month, let the birds empty the feeder as far as they can. Shake out any remaining debris. Soak the feeder in a 50/50 solution of white vinegar and hot water, and then scrub with the Bird Feeder Brush to remove any remaining debris. Rotate the brush to get in between obstacles inside the tube. Rinse the feeder well and allow to dry thoroughly before refilling. Then rinse your Bird Feeder Brush thoroughly and hang to dry. This quality brush will last for years with proper care.

At least once a year, disassemble the feeder completely to wash all feeder parts. In summer, clean your feeder more often as needed – bacteria spread more quickly in hot weather.
